### The Inquisition in the Portuguese Empire

In the second part of her talk on the Portuguese Inquisition, Rachel Barnard turns her attention to the activities of the Inquisition in the Empire. Established in Portugal in 1536 and abolished only in 1821, the Inquisition established its eastern headquarters in Goa in 1560. The administrative centre of the Inquisition continued in Lisbon. The Lisbon tribunal was responsible for all prosecutions originating in Portuguese possessions on the Atlantic. Who were the targets of the Inquisition in the Empire? Why were these people prosecuted? How did the central headquarters of the Inquisition attempt to control the principles and methods used by the prosecutors in such a wide diversity of cultures?

What effect did the Inquisition have on the Syrian St Thomas Christians, those Christians who had been established in India before the Portuguese arrived in 1498? The Portuguese Inquisition was also active in Brazil, and after the Dutch were forced to leave Brazil in 1654 many Jews who had sheltered under the tolerant Dutch flag also chose to leave. Join Rachel for part two, as she completes her survey of the Inquisition in the history of Portugal.
