Portuguese Fishing in the North Atlantic

Arne will answer such questions as: Who were the dory men? Why do Catholics eat fish on Fridays? How is the trade embargo for export of fish to Russia interfering with Portuguese interest? What was Salazar's interest in dory fishing? Why do cod fish have a chin appendix and what was the significance for the Is it proven that Portuguese fishermen fishermen? came to Nova Scotia several years before Columbus landed in the Caribbean? How large is Portugal's responsibility for fishery controls in the Atlantic? How was the Portuguese rigging of their sails different and better than those used by Columbus'? Is there a positive future for cod fishing in the North Atlantic? What are the facts about "grinde" whales around the Faroe islands? Arne was born in Copenhagen and he worked all over Europe selling textile products from factories in Mexico, South America and Japan. became an export consultant in Houston and he and his third (and last, they say) wife Barbara later moved to St John in the US Virgin Islands, where they ran a business selling tourist guidebooks, maps and advertising. They moved to the Algarve in 1999.

A Social History of Tavira

In May last year Peter discussed the built environment of Tavira, and this lecture will concentrate on the people of the town. How highly did they rate in the social strata of Portugal? Tavira has been a town of great significance in the history of Portugal, but is much less so nowadays; when did its importance wane, and why? Who built the twenty-one churches in the town? How did the people of Tavira make their living, and what problems did they encounter through the years? How important have the fisheries on this coast been to the town, and how has the town coped with the moving sandbanks? There have of course been invasions and wars and civil disturbances which inevitably affected the town, but what was the role of the people of Tavira in these upheavals? Lastly, what role does the town play in the present day Algarve?
