The Evolution of Mainframe Security to Cybersecurity

This talk will be of interest to all people with computers, as Jim will discuss how Mainframe security evolved to Cybersecurity. He will answer such questions as: Why are the projected losses to Cybercrime projected to be 2 trillion Euros by 2019? Jim has been involved with computer security since the 70s as Naval Cryptologist, Project Officer at NSA, Chief of Staff at the National Computer Security Center, Johns Hopkins' Professor, executive at two major Computer Security vendors, and independent consultant supporting over 300 security assessments of commercial, military and government systems, including the White House and the first Internet Gambling Jim will explain the difference in needs for com-Casino. puter security as the systems and commerce evolved from Mainframes to Clouds and how the threat evolved. He will explain in non-technical terms what Firewalls, Cryptography, and Anti-Virus/SPAM are and how they protect your information. Jim is an author of 5 cybersecurity books and has presented to conferences and classes all over the world. Jim has lived fulltime in Ferragudo since 2010 and is a Board member and Cybersecurity Advisor for Safe Communities Portugal.

D Fernando II, The German Consort

In the mid-nineteenth century, there was an amazing similarity between the United Kingdom of Britain and Ireland, and the Kingdom of Portugal and the Algarves. Each country found itself ruled by a young Queen in need of a husband. Queen Maria II of Portugal and Queen Victoria found her future spouse in the same German family, that of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha. At the age of 18 in 1836, Queen Maria II married her Ferdinand (her third husband). And in 1840 at the age of 20, Queen Victoria married her first husband Albert, her own first cousin and the cousin of Ferdinand. Each of these marriages was both productive and short. Victoria had nine children before Albert died in 1861, and Maria had seven children before in 1853 she pegged out in childbed. Albert was regarded with suspicion by the political establishment in Britain and lent his weight to the abolition of slavery, the running of the Queen's household and the organization of the Great Exhibition. larly, Ferdinand was excluded from the government of Portugal, even though he was king in title. He was interested in art and architecture, and we owe to him the salvation of many of the buildings associated with the history of Portugal, such as the Mosteiro da Batalha and the Torre de Belém; and his own great contribution to Portugal's heritage, the Pena Palace in Sintra. Without Ferdinand's enormous contribution to his adopted country, the built environment which illustrates Portuguese history would be very much poorer.

Carola studied with Raymond Delnoye at the Tilburg Conservatory of Music. She graduated 'cum laude' as a teaching musician, performing musician and had a special recommendation in chamber music. Afterwards she studied with Gaby van Riet and joined masterclasses with Gaby van Riet, Trevor Wye, Peter-Lukas Graf, Emile Biessen and Johan

Rijcken. Carola won first prize in the Dutch National Flute Competition in 1985 and in 1986 received the Buma Trophy for the best performance of a Dutch composition. She played flute in several orchestras, including the Dutch Student Chamber Music Orchestra, the Jeunesses Musicales World Orchestra and has performed as soloist with the L'Orchestre International de Flandre.

Visit to Taran's Glass Art Workshop Since moving to the Algarve 13 years ago, Taran has devoted her time to learning about glass. She is self taught from a book, and she is constantly refining her knowledge about working with glass. In her small electric kiln, she makes a variety of objects: pictures, tiles, sculptures, bowls, plates, jewellery and candle holders. She finds her inspiration from nature and the colours and the light of the Algarve, and the results are both fascinating and stunning. Numbers are limited for this visit.
